SPRING CLEANING? Don't Forget Your HVAC System

As you start to see the first signs of spring and begin thinking about turning on your air conditioning, it's important to include your home's HVAC system in your spring cleaning plans. One of the best ways to ensure

your HVAC system is able to run at optimal efficiency is to perform a few simple maintenance tasks yourself. Most tasks involve light cleaning to maintain proper airflow and operation and can easily be incorporated into your other spring cleaning and yardwork. Here's what you can do.

- **1.** Clean or change the filter on the indoor unit of your HVAC system according to the manufacturer's instructions, typically every one to three months.
- **2.** Remove any debris such as leaves and sticks from on or around your outdoor HVAC unit.
- **3.** Clean the coils of the outdoor unit with a garden hose whenever they appear dirty. Use only light water pressure so you don't damage the fins.
- **4.** Clean your indoor vents with a dusting cloth or vacuum.
- 5. Move any furniture or objects away from the vents so air flows freely.

CAN TREE ROOTS Damage Your Sewer Pipe?

Heavy rain in early spring can cause your trees and shrubs to grow like gangbusters. Above ground, everything looks lush and beautiful, but below the surface, all those new tree roots may be taking over—punching holes, building blockages, and in extreme cases crushing your sewer pipe. If you know where the sewer pipe on your property is located, you can often judge what may be going on underground by what's going on above ground. If the area is thick with vegetation, that's a great reason to have a professional inspect the situation.

Many plumbing problems around your home are preventable with proper drain and sewer maintenance. If you suspect there's something going on in your sewer system or you just want to be proactive, have a qualified technician perform an inspection to identify any areas in need of repair or replacement and to determine any services you may need, such as drain cleaning or sewer jetting. In January, Federal Energy Property Tax Credits were reinstated and applied retroactively from 12/31/2017 through 12/31/2020. These Federal Tax Credits are applicable to primary residences only. Please consult your tax professional to see how this program applies to your circumstances.

Central Air Conditioning

Tax Credit Amount: \$300 *Split System Requirements:* SEER >=16 EER >=13

Gas, Oil, or Propane Water Heater Tax Credit Amount: \$300 *Requirements:* Energy Factor > 0.82 OR thermal efficiency of at least 90%

Electric Heat Pump Water Heater Tax Credit Amount: \$300 *Requirements:*

Energy Factor >= 2.2

Geothermal Heat Pumps Tax Credit: 26% for systems placed in service before 1/1/2021

Heat Pumps

Tax Credit Amount: \$300 *Split System Requirements:* HSPF >= 8.5 EER >= 12.5 SEER >= 15

Boilers

Tax Credit Amount: \$150 *Requirements:* AFUE >= 95

Gas, Propane, or Oil Furnaces and Fans

Tax Credit Amount: \$150 *Requirements:* AFUE >= 95

Non-Business Energy Property Tax Credits

Retroactively extended from 12/31/2017 to 12/31/2020. Tax Credit: 10% of cost up to \$500 or a specific amount from \$50 to \$300
